


Our Missionary Family

We want everyone everywhere to know how great God is!




We live like the people we serve . . .

We try to be Christ's hands . . .




. . and His feet.






We try to do what He would do . . .

Here are some tips to help you get started in your missionary work:

- 1. Talk to Jesus a lot! You cannot be good without His help (John 15:5); so make a definite time every day to be alone with Him in prayer, and ask Him to show you what He wants you to do and who He wants you to help.
- Make a habit of sharing. If you have two of something, give one away (Luke 3:11). If you have one thing that makes you especially happy, let someone else feel that same happiness by letting him have a turn with it (Matthew 22:39).
- 3. Smile! There's always *something* to be happy about, and smiles are contagious!
